## Program Rates

Ginjer provides up to four in-person presentations per day. Group sizes should be limited to approximately 200 students per session to keep the presentations intimate and interactive.

For schools within 100 miles of Richmond, VA, the fee is \$300 per session. Up to 200 miles is \$400 per session plus overnight accommodation. Presentations beyond that distance are \$500 per session plus travel and accommodation. Virtual visits are \$200 per session.
